The hepatitis C virus still represents the main cause of chronic liver disease in our country. In this rapidly changing field, more and more drugs offer interesting treatment perspectives. However, pros and cons of universal vs. restricted treatment should be discussed, based on cost analysis and resources availability. In Italy, till now, only patients with advanced fibrosis and cirrhosis can be treated and reimbursed.

New treatment schedules, generic drugs, and new molecules in different clinical settings require a specific discussion. The upcoming new single pills with very short course of treatment including the triplet containing PI,s is beyond the corner. The Meeting is targeted to specialists in Internal Medicine, Hepatology, Gastroenterology, and Infectious Diseases, aiming to provide them with the opportunity to interact with the Experts and discuss all the clinical issues of chronic hepatitis C and its complication.
